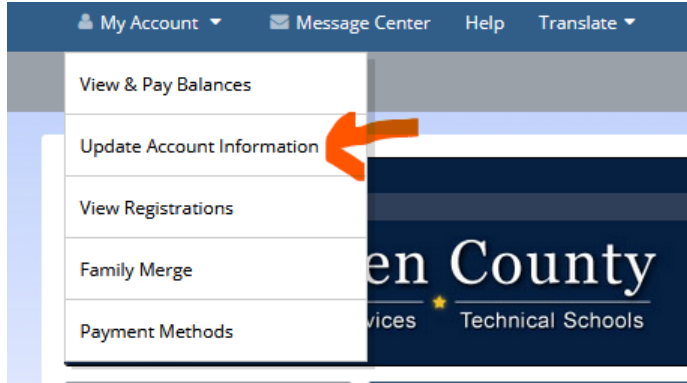


## How to register for the 2021 Joe Holbrook Memorial Math Competition

First, go to <https://www.bergen.org/register>. This will redirect you to CommunityPass, the system that the Bergen County Technical Schools is using for all online registration.

If you already have a CommunityPass account (either through a BCTS program like Academy After Hours or a program with another organization), you can use the same account. **One account is sufficient for a family** and can be used to register as many students as needed.



Once you have logged in, go to the My Account menu in the top left corner, and select Update Account Information, as seen at left. This will allow you to **create a profile for each child**.

Once you have created profiles for all children, hit the “Home” button in the top left corner.

Hit the “Click Here to Register” button next to “Bergen County Technical Schools”, as seen at right.

You will be asked to confirm contact information for the parent/guardian.

On the left side, find the “Search a keyword” box and **search for “Holbrook”**.



CommunityPass is a partnership of the local community organizations.  
From here you can register for an activity, see your family's current registrations or edit your account information.

The Bergen County Technical Schools District was founded in 1951 to oversee the County's growing need for vocational education. The following year, Bergen County Vocational-Technical High School, the first full-time facility of its kind in the state, opened at 200 Hackensack Avenue. At that time, students studied the union trades of plumbing, carpentry, masonry, and electrical work.

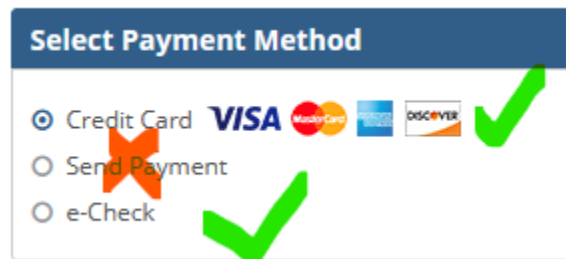

There are two sessions for the competition. The morning session is for Grades 4-6 (as well as younger students taking the Grade 4 contest). The afternoon session is for Grades 7-8. **Each student can only take one contest.**

Click “Add to Cart” and select the checkboxes for each student taking the competition.

In the top right corner, select “Checkout”. This will give you a chance to confirm the grade, date of birth, and gender of each child. Then confirm your agreement to the competition rules. Finally, you can select your method of payment (Credit Card or e-Check). Please **do not select “Send Payment”** as we will not be able to confirm receipt of mailed checks before the competition. Enter your credit card or checking account details, and submit payment.



You will receive an email confirmation of your registration from CommunityPass within a few minutes of completing your transaction.
